

Are you starting treatment with a biologic, biosimilar or other new therapy?

The BSRBR-RA is a national research study that collects information from patients who are starting a biologic, biosimilar or other new treatment for Rheumatoid Arthritis. It is an observational study (not a clinical trial) so we simply watch what happens to you when your doctor prescribes your therapy. This data helps to better understand the long-term safety and effectiveness of these therapies.
